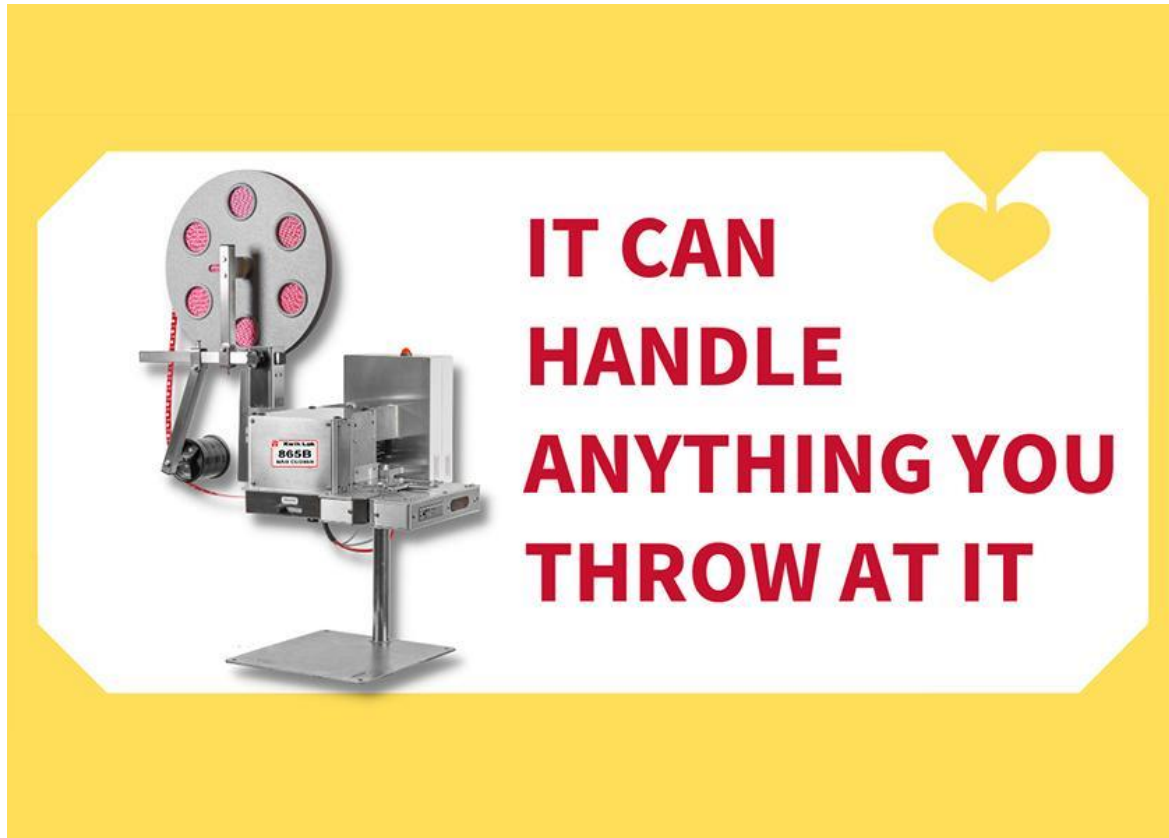


Kwik Lok to introduce new closing machine at IFPA show
